AMENDMENTS 11-27

AMENDMENT II

Prevents states from being sued by someone in another state

 The President and Vice President are elected on separate ballots by the Electoral College (public sees them on the same ballot)

Abolishes Slavery

- Defines Citizenship (jus soli, jus sanguine)
- Due Process at State level
- CIVIL RIGHTS!!!!!!!

Right to vote cannot be denied based on race, color or creed

Authorizes income tax

Senators are voted by the voters in each state

Outlawed making, selling or distribution of Alcohol

- Women's suffrage (right to vote)
- No person will be denied the right to vote based on their gender

- The presidents term starts January 20
- This is known as the "Lame Duck" amendment because no one has political power

Repeals the 18th Amendment

A president can only serve 2 terms, or a maximum of 10 years

■ The District of Columbia is given 3 electoral votes

Prohibits the government from charging a fee to vote (no poll tax)

- Presidential Succession
- If the President dies, the Vice President becomes President.
- If both of them die...

Minimum voting age set to 18

Limits congressional pay raises
