




- FREEDOM OF RELIGION, ASSEMBLY, PRESS, PETITION, SPEECH
- ESTABLISHMENT CLAUSE: THE GOVERNMENT CANNOT ESTABLISH AN OFFICIAL RELIGION THAT THE POPULATION HAS TO FOLLOW
- FREE EXERCISE CLAUSE: WE CAN PRACTICE WHATEVER RELIGION WE WANT

• PROTECTION AGAINST UNREASONABLE SEARCH AND SEIZURE



AMENDMENT 5 S E D D

- INDICTMENT BY A GRAND JURY: A FORMAL CHARGE FOR A CRIME
- NO DOUBLE JEOPARDY (CAN'T BE TRIED TWICE FOR SAME CRIME)
- NO SELF INCRIMINATION: DON'T HAVE TO TELL ON YOURSELF
- DUE PROCESS: GOVERNMENT HAS TO FOLLOW PROCEDURE AND LAWS
- EMINENT DOMAIN: GOVERNMENT CAN TAKE YOUR PROPERTY FOR PUBLIC USE



- RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY
- SPEEDY AND PUBLIC TRIAL
- RIGHT TO AN ATTORNEY (LAWYER)





• RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL IN CIVIL CASES WHERE THE AMOUNT IS MORE THAN \$20



- NO CRUEL AND UNUSUAL PUNISHMENT
- NO EXCESSIVE BAIL





- UNENUMERATED RIGHTS:
- RIGHTS NOT LISTED
 - EX. PRIVACY IN YOUR OWN HOME
 - FREELY MOVE AROUND THE COUNTRY



• RESERVED POWERS FOR THE STATES
