- Registering to vote and actual voting
- Staying informed
- Volunteering
- Lobbying
- Petitioning
- Running for office

- Voting is necessary to have a true democracy. The more active people are, the more representative our government is.
- Requirements to vote:
 - Registered and 18 yrs old
 - Not a felon (or in certain states after a certain time frame)
 - Live in the are for 30 days

Civil Disobedience

- Is breaking an unjust law in a peaceful way in order to bring attention to it's inequality
- Used in the Civil Rights movement and by Ghandi
- Communities need: unity about an issue
- Self Determinism: making goals and following through
